## **PREAMBLE**

The blood donation camp is organized in MITK campus, here individuals can voluntarily donate their blood for medical purposes. Donating blood is a noble act that helps save lives, and participating in a blood donation camp can make a positive impact on the community's healthcare needs.

#### REPORT

The NSS and YRC unit organized a "Blood donation camp" on 02/12/2021 in MITK campus, where our students voluntarily donated bloods to help the needy people. Firstly, there was a stage program where the resource person mentioned the importance of donating blood where he told about the primary goal of blood donation camps is to ensure a steady and sufficient supply of blood for medical treatments, surgeries, emergencies, and other healthcare needs. The stage program was hosted by prof. Sookshma Adiga, principal Dr. Chandra rao Madane, vice principal Mr. Melwin D'Souza and NSS coordinators Balanageshwara and YRC Coordinator Varuna kumara were present.

Lately, the camp arrangement was done with comfortable seating for donors, medical equipment, and a dedicated area for medical staff to perform the donation procedure. The blood donation process involved several steps:

**Donor Screening:** Medical staff assess the donor's health history, recent travel, and potential risk factors to ensure the safety of both the donor and the recipient.

**Hemoglobin Test:** A quick hemoglobin test is performed to ensure the donor has an adequate level of hemoglobin in their blood.

**Donation:** If the donor passes the screening, they are guided to a donation area where a unit of blood (usually about 500 ml) is collected using a sterile needle and collection bag. The process typically takes around 10-15 minutes.

**Post-Donation Care:** After donation, donors are provided with refreshments and are encouraged to rest for a short period to prevent dizziness or fainting.

**Donor Eligibility:** Donors need to meet specific eligibility criteria to ensure the safety of both the donor and the recipient. Common criteria include age, weight, general health, absence of certain medical conditions, and recent travel history.

**Record Keeping:** Donor information, blood type, and other relevant details are recorded for future reference. Donors may receive a donor card or a digital record of their donation.
