BRIEF PROFILE THE TRUST:

Manasa Jyothi Trust was started in 2000 with support from a local Trust. The Trust continues to be active and needs a lot of support. The school is actively managed by Shobha Madhyastha and Maartje van den Brand a Physiotherapist from The Netherlands. The school is not funded by the government but by a private Trust and does not ask the parents for any fee. Therefore, *Manasa Jyothi* provides, for disabled children without parents or with parents, who cannot or do not want to care for them, a place to live and receive education. For some children this school is their only chance in society.

REPORT

As a part of Founder's Day celebration, a group of students from our college had the privilege of visiting Manasajyothi trust, koni on 30/03/2023.

Objectives:

The objectives of the visit were as follows:

1. To gain insight into the learning environment and methods used to support mentally and physically challenged children.
