**Winners:** After careful deliberation, the following students emerged as the winners:

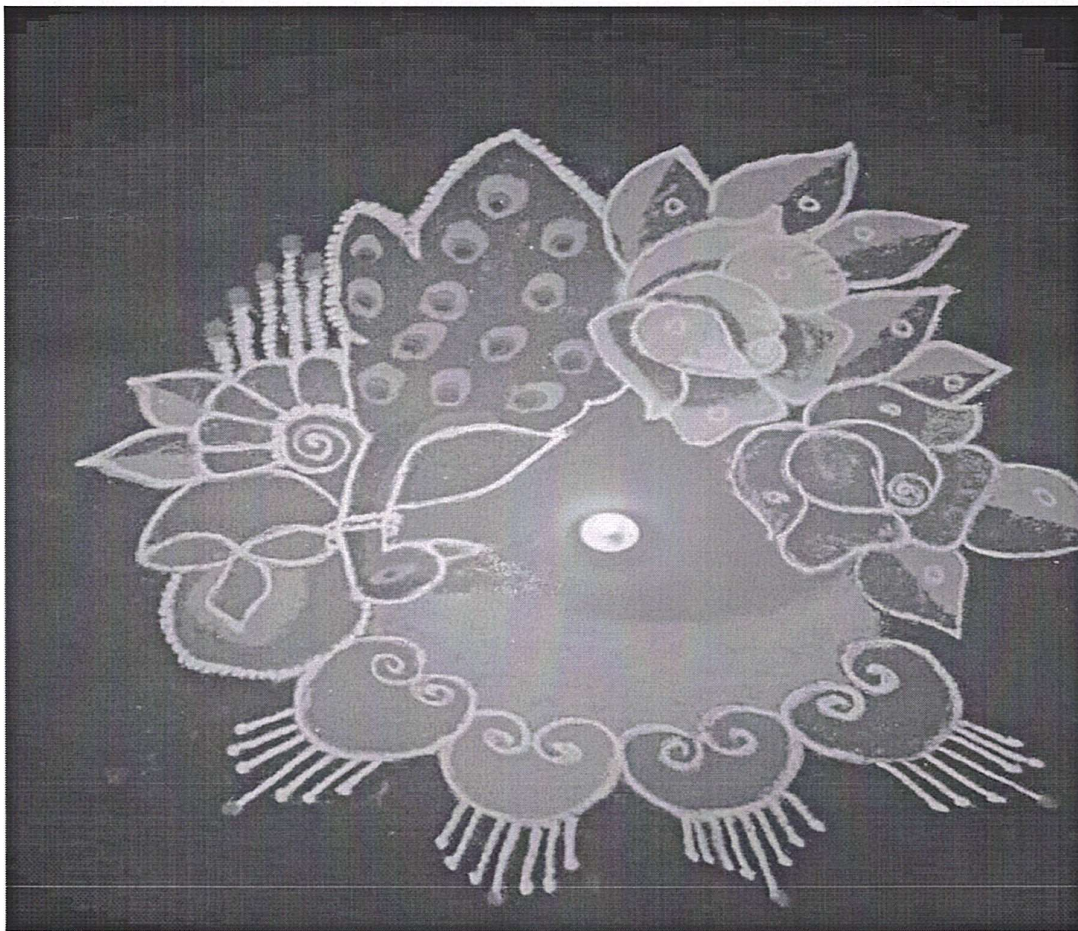
**First Place:** Akshatha, EEE

**Second Place:** Navya, ECE

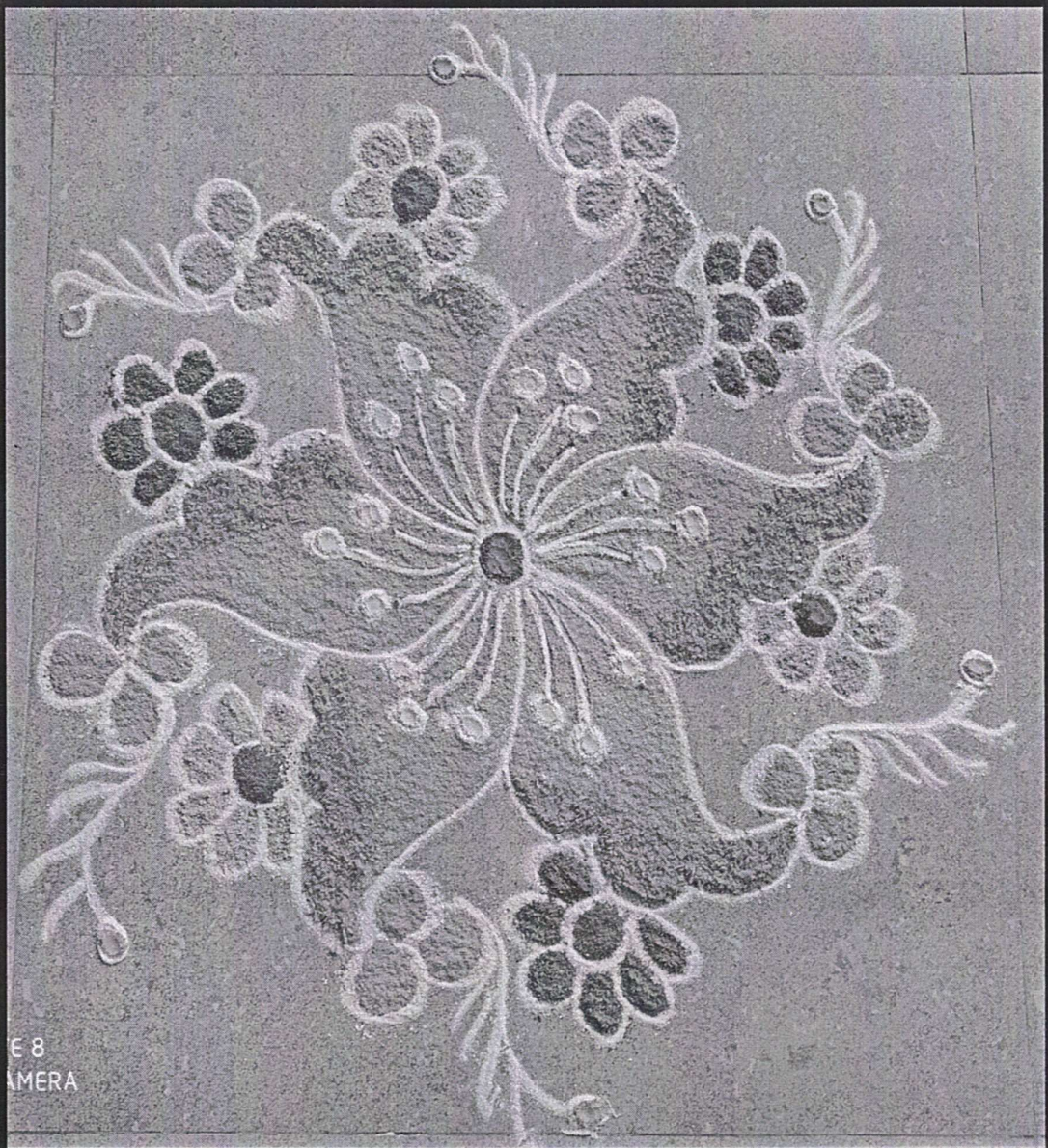
**Prizes:** The winners received certificates of excellence and exciting prizes as tokens of recognition for their artistic achievements.

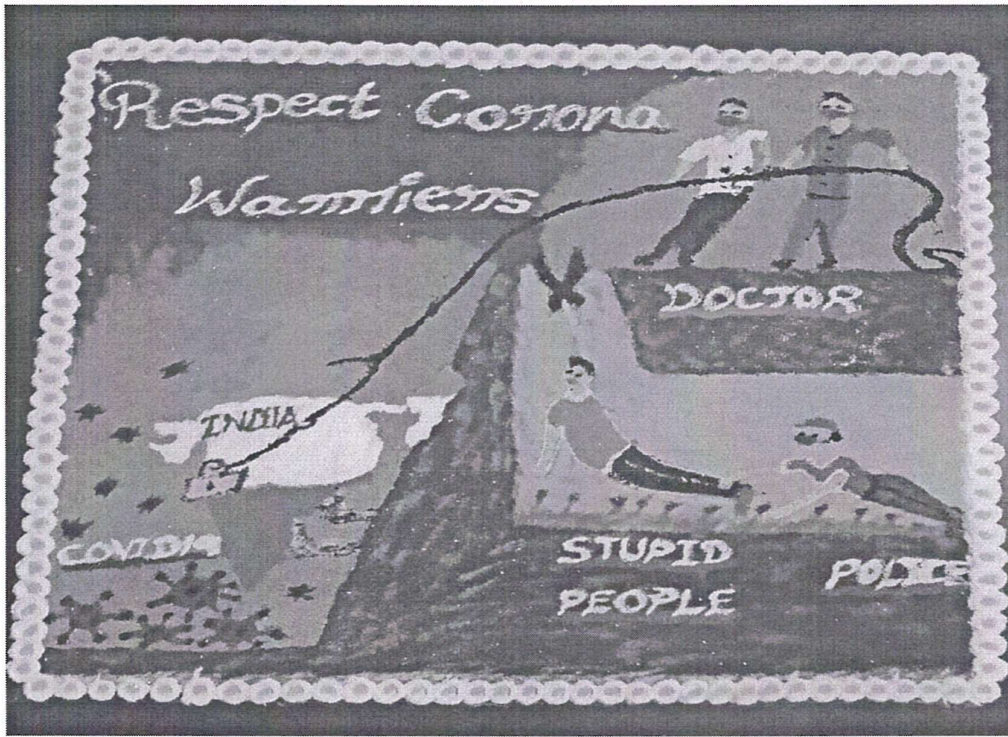
