- Aptitude Practice tests were conducted on Syapee portal

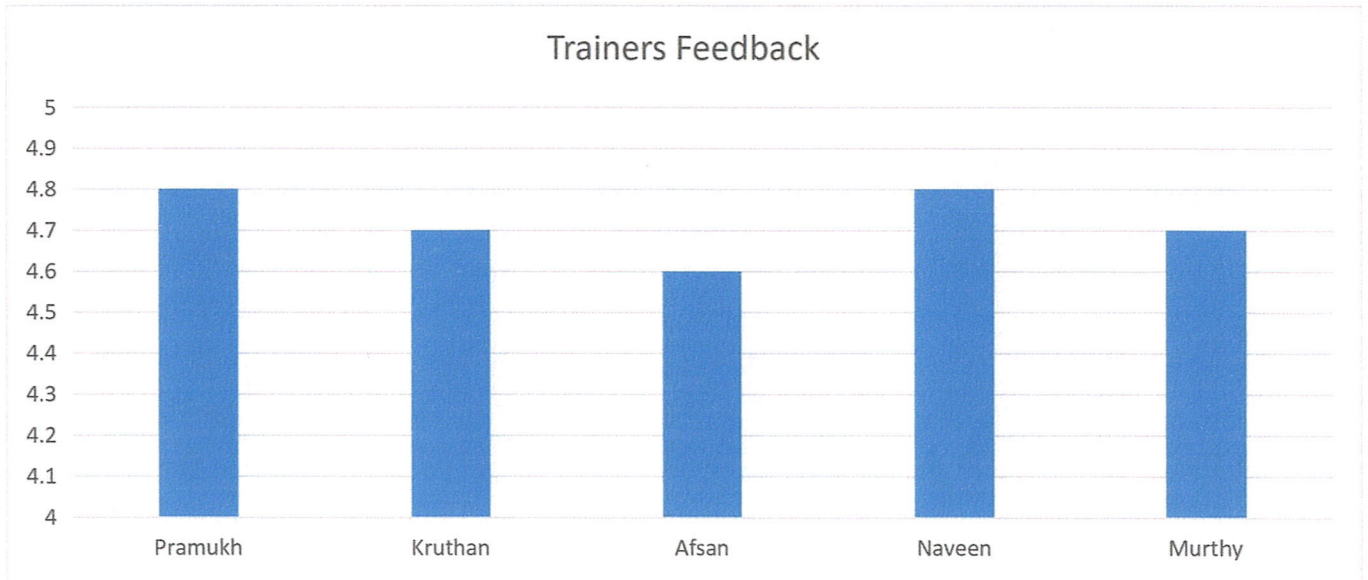
Training Methodology:
