Minutes of the IQAC Meeting Scheduled on 21/01/2019

Venue: Seminar Hall, MITK

Time: 03:30 PM

Meeting started with a welcome note by Principal. The meeting was addressed by the coordinator Prof. Thimmappa D S on following matters.

1. Review of preparation of all the departments for NAAC Accreditation:

In the review of preparation for NAAC Accreditation, the Heads of Departments (HODs) were directed to compile comprehensive reports detailing the workshops and activities conducted throughout the academic year 2018-19. Additionally, it was suggested that each department conduct a minimum of two technical talks, with participation from industry experts, to enrich students' understanding of current industry practices and trends. Moreover, departments were encouraged to organize industry visits or internships for students to gain practical exposure and insight into their respective fields. Finally, departments were urged to actively engage in community outreach programs, fostering partnerships with local organizations to address societal needs through innovative projects and initiatives.

2. Discussion on strengthening training and placement activities:

Dhanya Shenoy, the placement director, briefed about the placements that occurred last year. She also outlined the measures taken to enhance students' employability through industry-specific training. She expressed concern about the lack of publicity surrounding positive developments in the college. She suggested introducing NPTEL courses to help students score better marks and gain a deeper understanding of subjects. Additionally, she emphasized the importance of training students for specific job roles, in addition to developing analytical, reasoning, and communication skills.

3. Implementation of all such activities which improve the outcome

Prof. Thimmappa D S briefed on the initiatives taken up by the college to improve outcome-based learning, emphasizing the effectiveness of collaborating with industries. He highlighted that the college has partnered with industries to provide hands-on training and job opportunities. Working with industry leaders enables students to participate in internships, attend talks, and engage in projects that offer real-world insights. The college prioritizes experiential learning, ensuring students have ample opportunities to work on projects and utilize modern labs. This approach enhances their understanding and proficiency in their studies. Additionally, the college provides guidance and conducts practice interviews to prepare students for the job market, instilling confidence in them as they transition to their professional careers.

4. Construction of Board Room

To meet the growing needs of our college community, the management recognized the need for a dedicated meeting space. The chairman assured that a fully furnished boardroom will be constructed to facilitate meetings and discussions effectively. This new addition will serve as a hub for collaboration, decision-making, and fostering a sense of community within the college. With this initiative, we aim to provide a conducive environment for constructive dialogue and strategic planning, further enhancing the overall experience for students, faculty, and staff alike.
